PRESIDENTIAL PRAYER REQUESTS FOR DECEMBER 8, 2005

As the 9/11 Commission has warned that we are ill-prepared for another terrorist attack, pray for the President and Congress as they respond to these concerns, making changes to our communication, security and travel systems.
